A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL TO APPROPRIATE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS FOR A TEMPORARY COVID PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, in March 2020, federal, state and local government officials issued various declarations of public health states of emergency in response to the global spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has affected many individuals and families in Albany; and

WHEREAS, the City has been allocated \$4,711,702 in American Rescue Plan Act funds; and

WHEREAS, use of said funds is prescriptive in nature per the terms of the American Rescue Plan Act; and

WHEREAS, aiding residents that have been adversely affected by the pandemic falls in the US Treasury Interim Final Rule spending category of Public Health and Economic Impacts; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council has expressed an interest to assist those most affected by the COVID-19 pandemic with the one-time funding available from the American Rescue Plan Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby appropriates \$900,000 in American Rescue Plan Act funds to create and market a Temporary COVID Public Assistance Program including a temporary COVID Community Engagement Specialist to facilitate the program.
