A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL TO AWARD CONTRACT NO. C22-24 TO PLACEWORKS FOR PARK AND LANDSCAPED AREAS GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM (GIS) SUPPORT SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Short-Lived Climate Pollutant Reduction Act of 2016 (Senate Bill 1383) is a state mandate requiring diversion of 75% of organic waste from landfills and recovery of 20% of edible food statewide by 2025; and

WHEREAS, this mandate requires Albany to purchase 1,364 tons of recycled organic waste products per year which can include compost and mulch; and

WHEREAS, a geographic database of park and landscaped areas would be useful in identifying park and landscaped areas to apply compost and mulch, thus helping Albany meet those procurement targets; and

WHEREAS, Measure D funds are available and appropriate to use for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to award Contract No. C22-24 to PlaceWorks in the amount of \$29,000.00 for Park and Landscaped Areas GIS Support Services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby appropriates \$29,000 from Measure D (The Alameda County Waste Reduction and Recycling Initiative 1989) funds for this contract, to be incorporated into the Public Works Operating Budget.
