A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING ONE ADDITIONAL MEETING OF THE COMMUNITY TASK FORCE ON POLICING

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-107, creating the Community Task Force on Policing ("the Task Force") on November 16, 2020 and charged it with examining "policy and practices especially those that have negatively impacted community members and relationships to include data collection to identify key racial equity challenges to prioritize;" researching "best practices in other jurisdictions and examine possible alternatives;" defining "communication pathways of various stakeholders to include community input as well as progress of the work;" and ensuring "an environment where members of the public feel safe calling on and interacting with the police"; and

WHEREAS, per Resolution No. 2020-107, the Task Force shall serve for a period of six months, with the option for up to 3-month extension pending authorization by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force met in the months of May, June, July, September, October and November per Council direction and with the City Council's subsequent authorization of a 3-month extension, the Task Force continued to meet in December, January and February; and

WHEREAS, it was requested for the City Council to authorize one additional meeting for the Task Force to complete their work relating to budget and data.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes one additional meeting for the Community Task Force on Policing to meet in April 2022.
