

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CALL FOR BIDS FOR PHASE 5 OF THE ANNUAL SIDEWALK REHABILITATION PROGRAM (CIP NO. 22000)

WHEREAS, the residents of Albany have recognized the need for safe, passable sidewalks to improve walkability throughout the City's entire network; and

WHEREAS, under Section 5610 of the California Streets and Highways Code and per Albany Municipal Code Section 14-1.5b, property owners and persons in possession of property are required to maintain adjacent public sidewalks in a safe condition; and

WHEREAS, in November 2016, Albany voters approved Measure P1, a parcel tax for the purposes of publicly funding repairs to the City sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the existence of a tax-funded City sidewalk repair program does not abrogate the responsibility of property owners to maintain their frontage improvements in a safe manner; and

WHEREAS, the budget for the Annual Sidewalk Rehabilitation Program (CIP No. 22000) was adopted as part of the City's five-year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP), most recently updated in November 2020 (Resolution No. 2020-108); and

WHEREAS, new criteria have been developed for determination of scope for each round of City-sponsored repairs, as part of an extensive Citywide survey of the City's sidewalk network, with an eye to ADA (American Disability Act) compliance and safe passability; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Commission has approved these modified prioritization criteria as well as a list of locations for the Phase 5 Project under the Annual Sidewalk Rehabilitation Program (CIP No. 22000).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the Call for Bids for the Phase 5 Project of the Annual Sidewalk Rehabilitation Program (Contract No. C22-14).
