**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
THE ENCRYPTION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT RADIOS TO
COMPLY WITH CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (CA DOJ)
AND FBI POLICES, PRACTICES AND PROCEDURES**

WHEREAS, the State Citizens Option for Public Safety (COPS) grant program provides money to local police agencies for the purpose of enhancing public safety by supporting front line law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the Albany Police Department has identified a need to encrypt 51 police radios to fulfill its policing mission; and

WHEREAS, this encryption will allow the Albany Police Department to comply with CA DOJ (California Department of Justice) and FBI CJIS (Federal Bureau of Investigation Criminal Justice Information Services) Policies, Practices and Procedures; and

WHEREAS, Motorola Solutions, Inc. is a sole source vendor responsible for the maintenance for the East Bay Regional Communications System Authority (EBRCSA); and

WHEREAS, Red Cloud, Inc., the local vendor for Motorola, Inc. will provide the encryption software; and

WHEREAS, Alameda County ITD Radio Services Group that maintains our radios will perform the software installation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Albany City Council authorizes the appropriation of COPS grant funds to pay for the encryption of 51 police radios and that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the purchase of the software to encrypt 51 police radios from sole source vendor Red Cloud, Inc., using COPS grant funds not to exceed \$42,629.63.
