

1 and all other persons and procedures for the General Municipal Election shall be the same as those
2 utilized by the County of Alameda.


3 SECTION 6. In all particulars not recited in this Resolution, the election shall be held and
4 conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

5 SECTION 7. The notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the
6 Election Official is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the
7 election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

8 SECTION 8. The City Council authorizes the Election Official to administer said
9 election, and all reasonable and actual election expenses shall be paid by the City upon presentation
10 of properly submitted bills.

11 SECTION 9. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and shall
12 cause notice of the election, the offices to be filled, and other matters relating to the election to be
13 given as required by the Elections Code of the State of California.

14 SECTION 10. The City Clerk shall, not later than the 88th day prior to the General
15 Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, file with the Board of Supervisors
16 and the Registrar of Voters of the County of Alameda, State of California, a certified copy of this
17 Resolution.
