

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-75

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY,
CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
THE COUNTY OF ALAMEDA TO CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL
ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2022, ON THE SAME
DATE WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION PURSUANT TO
SECTION 10403 OF THE CALIFORNIA ELECTIONS CODE**

WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution No. 2022-74 on July 5, 2022, the City Council has called and given notice of a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 in the City of Albany, County of Alameda, for the purpose of electing two (2) Members of the City Council for a full term of four (4) years and three (3) Members of the Board of Education for a full term of four (4) years at said General Municipal Election using ranked-choice voting at large; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date, and that within the City the precincts, polling places, vote centers, and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the Alameda County Registrar of Voters canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election, and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of Section 10403 of the California Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, for the purpose of the election of two (2) Members of the City Council for a full term of four (4) years and three (3) Members of the Board of Education for a full term of four (4) years using ranked-choice voting at large in accordance with Measure BB approved by voters in 2020 and Chapter VII of the Albany Municipal Code.

1 SECTION 2. That the Alameda County Registrar of Voters is authorized to canvass the
2 returns of the General Municipal Election for the City of Albany. The election shall be held in all
3 respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used. Pursuant to
4 Elections Code Section 10418, the election will be held and conducted in accordance with the
5 provisions of law regulating the Statewide General Election.

7 SECTION 3. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda is requested to issue
8 instructions to the Alameda County Registrar of Voters to take any and all steps necessary for the
9 holding of the consolidated election.

11 SECTION 4. That the City of Albany recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by
12 the County of Alameda by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County of
13 Alameda for any costs upon presentation of reasonably detailed invoices.

15 SECTION 5. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to forward without delay a certified
16 copy of this resolution to both the Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda and the Alameda
17 County Registrar of Voters.

19 SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this
20 Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
