A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE FOR THE ALBANY COMMUNITY TRIATHLON ON OCTOBER 16, 2022


WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code section 21101 requires the City to approve by resolution the temporarily closure of any street for celebrations, parades, local special events, and other purposes when the closure is necessary for the safety and protection of persons who are to use that portion of the street during the temporary closure; and

WHEREAS, use of the public right-of-way is regulated by Section 14-2 of the Albany Municipal Code. Per the Municipal Code, applications for work or use of the public right of way are processed in the form of an encroachment permit, which is subject to the approval of the Community Development Director; and

WHEREAS, the Albany Community Triathlon is a one-day event fundraiser for Albany Middle School and High School which has been held every year since 2008, except in 2020 and 2021 due to the COVID pandemic, around the Memorial Park and Albany High School blocks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the partial closure of Portland Avenue, Key Route Boulevard, Thousand Oaks Boulevard, and Carmel Avenue to accommodate the Albany Community Triathlon event on October 16, 2022.
