### **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-84**

# A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CALL FOR BIDS FOR THE 2022 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT (CONTRACT NO. C22-30) UNDER THE ANNUAL STREETS REHABILITATION PROGRAM (CIP NO. 21000)

**WHEREAS**, the City of Albany maintains 30 miles of public streets and roadways, with an overall pavement condition index (PCI) of 60 as of 2019; and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-108 for the FY19/20-23/24 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and appropriated budget for the first three fiscal years of the program; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Street Rehabilitation Program (CIP No. 21000) is included in the CIP, and reflects the City's commitment to ongoing investment into improving and maintaining City street conditions, including the Citywide PCI, on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the project consists of the rehabilitation of the portions of Jackson Street between Washington Avenue and its northern terminus, Kains Avenue between Marin Avenue and the southern city limits, Cornell Avenue between Washington Avenue and Marin Avenue, Evelyn Avenue between Solano Avenue and Dartmouth Street, Masonic Avenue between Portland Avenue and Solano Avenue, and Carmel Avenue between Washington Avenue and Marin Avenue, including paving restoration, traffic calming, storm drain pipe repair, concrete curbs and gutters, sidewalk, eight new curb ramps, valley gutters, street base repairs, subgrade preparation, hot-mix asphalt paving, pavement markings and striping for pedestrian and bicycle use; and

**WHEREAS**, the design of the 2022 Pavement Rehabilitation Project has been completed and the project is ready for construction; and

1	WHEREAS, the Project is determined to be categorically exempt under CEQA
2	(California Environmental Quality Act).

4	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that that the Albany City Council
5	authorizes the City Manager to approve a Call for Bids for construction of the 2022 Annual
6	Pavement Rehabilitation Project (Contract No. C22-30), which will utilize funds previously
7	appropriated under the Annual Street Rehabilitation Program (CIP No. 21000).
