## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-91**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ALAMEDA COUNTY TO CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022 WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 10403 OF THE ELECTIONS CODE FOR THE SUBMISSION OF ONE CITY TAX MEASURE AT SAID ELECTION

WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution No. 2022-77 on July 5, 2022, the City Council has called and given notice of a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 in the City of Albany, County of Alameda, for the purpose of submitting to the voters a question related to the City's new Emergency Medical Services, Advanced Life Support, and Fire Protection Tax (special); and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election for the tax measure be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that within the City, the precincts, polling places, vote centers and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the Alameda County election department canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** Request for Consolidation. Pursuant to the requirements of Section 10403 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General

Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, for the purpose of submitting to the voters the question relating to the City's Emergency Medical Services, Advanced Life Support, and Fire Protection Special Tax.

**SECTION 2.** Ballot Question for Measure. The ballot question for each measures is to appear on the ballot at the General Municipal Election as follows:

(A) For the Emergency Medical Services, Advanced Life Support, and Fire Protection Special Tax measure:

"To maintain and enhance local paramedic, advanced life support, firefighting services, firefighting equipment and ambulance service;	YES
shall a measure repealing the current two special emergency services	
taxes and adding a new Emergency Medical Services, Advanced Life	
Support, and Fire Protection Special Tax on residential and	
commercial property at \$0.074 per square foot of land, providing \$1,950,000 annually, subject to CPI adjustment, until ended by	NO
voters, exempting very low-income residents, with annual independent audits, be adopted?"	

SECTION 3. Canvass of Returns. The County election department is authorized to canvass the returns and perform all other proceedings incidental to and connected with the General Municipal Election. The Election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used. Pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 10403 and 10420, the election will be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of law regulating the Statewide General Election.

**SECTION 4.** Necessary Steps. The Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the County election department to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

**SECTION 5.** Costs. The City of Albany recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for any costs.

**SECTION 6.** Filing of Resolution. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the election department of the County of Alameda.

**SECTION 7.** Certification. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
