2 **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY,**  
3 **CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE FILING OF PRIMARY AND REBUTTAL**  
4 **ARGUMENTS AND SETTING RULES FOR THE FILING OF WRITTEN**  
5 **ARGUMENTS REGARDING ONE CITY TAX MEASURE TO BE SUBMITTED**  
6 **AT THE NOVEMBER 8, 2022 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

7 **WHEREAS,** a General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Albany, California  
8 on November 8, 2022, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following one City tax  
9 measure:

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“To maintain and enhance local paramedic, advanced life support, firefighting services, firefighting equipment and ambulance service; shall a measure repealing the current two special emergency services taxes and adding a new Emergency Medical Services, Advanced Life Support, and Fire Protection Special Tax on residential and commercial property at \$0.074 per square foot providing \$1,950,000 annually, subject to CPI adjustment, until ended by voters, exempting very low-income residents, with annual independent audits, be adopted?”	<b>YES</b>

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16 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY,**  
17 **CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS**  
18 **FOLLOWS:**

19 **Section 1. Primary Arguments.** That the City Council authorizes (i) the City Council  
20 or any member(s) of the City Council, (ii) any individual voter eligible to vote on the above  
21 measure, (iii) a bona fide association of such citizens or (iv) any combination of voters and  
22 associations, to file a written argument in favor of or against the City measure, accompanied by  
23 the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, in accordance with Article 4,  
24 Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California, and to change the argument  
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1 until and including the date fixed below by the City Clerk, after which no arguments for or against  
2 the City measure may be submitted to the City Clerk.

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4 The deadline to submit arguments for or against the City measure pursuant to this  
5 Resolution is declared by the City Clerk to be **Friday, August 19, 2022, at 12:00 p.m.** Each  
6 argument shall not exceed 300 words and shall be filed with the City Clerk, signed, and include  
7 the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an  
8 organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of  
9 its principal officers who is the author of the argument.  
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12 **Section 2. Rebuttal Arguments.** Pursuant to Section 9285 of the Elections Code of  
13 the State of California, when the City Clerk has selected the primary arguments for and against the  
14 City measure which will be printed and distributed to the voters, the Clerk shall send copies of the  
15 primary argument in favor of each measure to the authors of the primary argument against, and  
16 copies of the primary argument against to the authors of the primary argument in favor. The  
17 authors or persons designated by them may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not exceeding  
18 250 words. The rebuttal arguments shall be filed with the City Clerk not later than **Friday, August**  
19 **26, 2022, at 12:00 p.m.** Rebuttal arguments shall be printed in the same manner as the primary  
20 arguments. Each rebuttal argument shall immediately follow the primary argument which it seeks  
21 to rebut.  
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25 **Section 3. November 8, 2022 Election.** That the provisions of Sections 1 and 2 shall  
26 apply only to the election to be held on November 8, 2022, and shall then be repealed.  
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**Section 4. Certification.** The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
