1 ORDINANCE NO. 2022-04 2 AN ORDINANCE OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AMENDING 3 SECTION 2-3.1 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO APPOINTMENT OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER 4 5 6 WHEREAS, Albany Municipal Code ("AMC") section 2-3.1 establishes the process 7 for appointing, removing, and making severance payments to the Administrative Officer of the 8 City of Albany (the "City"); and 9 WHEREAS, the City wishes to amend section 2-3.1 to be gender neutral and delete the 10 provision requiring the City to continue to pay the Administrative Officer for 90 days upon 11 removal from office by the City Council. 12 13 NOW THEREFORE, THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL DOES ORDAIN AS 14 **FOLLOWS:** 15 **SECTION 1:** The recitals above are each incorporated by reference and adopted as findings 16 by the City Council. 17 18 **SECTION 2**: All amendments to the Albany Municipal Code as provided in this Ordinance are displayed with additions shown in underline and deletions shown in strikethrough. 19 20 **SECTION 3**: The City Council finds that this Ordinance is not subject to the requirements of 21 the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") for the following reasons: 22 A. This Ordinance is not a "project" within the meaning of Section 15378 of the State CEQA 23 Guidelines. (See State CEQA Guidelines, § 15060, subd. (c)(3) ["An activity is not 24 subject to CEQA if ... [t]he activity is not a project as defined in Section 15378"].) Here, 25 the Ordinance is not a "project" within the meaning of Section 15378 because the 26 Ordinance has no potential "for resulting in a direct physical change in the environment, 27 or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment." (State CEQA

Guidelines, § 15378.)

B. In the alternative, and if a project, this Ordinance is exempt under State CEQA (California Environmental Quality Act) Guidelines section 15061(b)(3), the common sense exemption, because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

SECTION 4: Section 2-3.1 of the Albany Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"2-3.1 Appointment.

The Administrative Officer shall be appointed by the City Council and serve at and during the pleasure of the Council; provided, however, the Administrative Officer shall not be removed from office during or within a period of ninety (90) days next succeeding any general municipal election in the City at which election a member of the Council is elected, except by a unanimous vote of the members of the Council. Such person shall be chosen on the basis of his or her their executive and administrative qualifications.

The purpose of this provision is to permit any newly elected member of the Council to observe the actions and ability of the Administrative Officer in the performance of the powers and duties of the office.

As severance consideration when removed from the office by the City Council, the Administrative Officer shall be entitled to be paid for a period of ninety (90) days after receiving formal notice of termination."

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity has no effect on the other provisions or applications of the Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this extent, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable. The City Council declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance irrespective of the invalidity of any portion thereof.

4	become effective thirty days after the date of its posting.
