A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Albany Fire Department is a single station agency; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department utilizes a front-line engine, ladder truck, brush engine and ambulance to respond to medical, fire, hazardous and environmental emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the use of source capture vehicle exhaust systems are shown to eliminate the exposure of carcinogenic vehicle exhaust; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department applied and was granted an award for the purchase and installation of a source capture vehicle exhaust system for the fire station from the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Albany City Council authorizes the City Manager to accept the grant award from Federal Emergency Management Agency Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program EMW-2021-FG-07270 of \$82,373.21; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Albany City Council authorizes the appropriation of \$8,237.33 from the Fire Department Reserve Funds as the required ten percent (10%) matching funds to purchase and install a source capture vehicle exhaust system in the Albany Fire Station.
