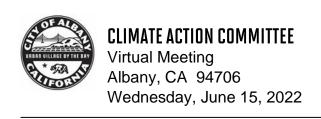
4-1. Sustainability Events and Resources

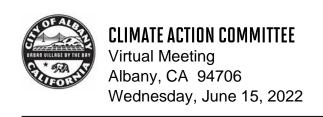
