## IN RECOGNITION OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH October 2022

WHEREAS, home should be a place of warmth, unconditional love, safety, and peace; and

WHEREAS, domestic violence touches the lives of Americans of all ages, leaving a devastating impact on women, men, and children of every background and circumstance; and

WHEREAS, domestic violence remains a major public health, social justice, and human rights issue requiring particular attention, and its interventions must be with the inclusion of both women and men at all levels; and

WHEREAS, freedom from domestic violence is a fundamental human right; and

WHEREAS, survivors of domestic violence must deal with the effects of physical injuries, long term psychological damage, financial instability, and trouble finding safe housing; and

WHEREAS, domestic violence encompasses various forms of abuse not always recognizable to members of the community, nor do victims or perpetrators of domestic violence fit a particular stereotype associated with the issue; and

WHEREAS, domestic violence is still the leading cause of injury to women; and

WHEREAS, every year millions of children are exposed to domestic violence which has long-lasting negative effects on children's emotional well-being, and social and academic functioning; and

WHEREAS, the presence of a firearm in a domestic violence situation increases the risk of homicide; and

WHEREAS, victims experiencing threats related to immigration status are often afraid to report abuse to due fears of detention and deportation.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Albany City Council does hereby proclaim October 2022 as Domestic Violence Awareness Month in the City of Albany.
