A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE FOR THE HOLIDAY MAKERS MARKET ON DECEMBER 10, 2022

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code section 21101 requires the City to approve by resolution the temporarily closure of any street for celebrations, parades, local special events, and other purposes when the closure is necessary for the safety and protection of persons who are to use that portion of the street during the temporary closure; and

WHEREAS, use of the public right-of-way is regulated by Section 14-2 of the Albany Municipal Code. Per the Municipal Code, applications for work or use of the public right of way are processed in the form of an encroachment permit, which is subject to the approval of the Community Development Director; and

WHEREAS, the Holiday Makers Market event is hosted by Picnic, an Albany business, as a way to generate economic development and community engagement on Solano Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the closure of the 1000 block of Solano Avenue between Adams Street and San Pablo Avenue to accommodate the Holiday Makers Market event on December 10, 2022.
