

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-09

AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, CALIFORNIA, ADDING A NEW SECTION 2-1.3 TO THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR FILLING A VACANT SEAT ON THE CITY COUNCIL BY APPOINTMENT, FOR THE IMMEDIATE PRESERVATION OF THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, AND SAFETY, AND DECLARING SAME TO BE AN URGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2022 City Council Member Ge'Nell Gary announced her resignation with last day of service being November 7, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.02 of the City Charter specifies that all City elected office vacancies "shall be filled by the Council; such appointee to hold office until the next feasible general municipal election, when a successor shall be chosen by the electors for the unexpired term"; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.02 of the City Charter further specifies that "The Council shall by ordinance establish procedures for filling a vacancy by appointment"; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance establishing procedures for filling a vacancy has yet to be adopted; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany General Municipal Election was recently held on November 8, 2022 which included five candidates on the ballot for the office of City Council with two seats up for election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a special meeting on November 9, 2022 to discuss the procedures for filling a vacant seat on the City Council by appointment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this Ordinance is necessary to effectively act in accordance with the requirements of the City Charter to timely fill a vacant seat on the City Council by appointment; and

WHEREAS, any and all other legal prerequisites relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have occurred.

NOW THEREFORE, THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The recitals above are each incorporated by reference and adopted as findings by the City Council.

SECTION 2: Declaration of Urgency. The City Council finds that the recitals set forth above are true and correct and hereby adopts and incorporates the recitals herein as findings in support of this Ordinance. Pursuant to City Charter Section 5.02, the City Council must take action within 60 days to fill a vacant seat on the City Council and must establish procedures for filling said vacancy. Further, the recent General Municipal Election resulted in the voters electing two candidates to fill seats on the City Council, and this third unexpected vacancy should coincide with the Oath of Office Ceremony for all new members of the City Council. To this end, the City Council finds that for the immediate preservation of the public peace declares this Urgency Ordinance to take effect immediately upon adoption by a four-fifths vote of the City Council.

SECTION 3: In accordance with the Albany City Charter Section 5.02 the procedure for filling a vacant seat on the Council specifically and solely for November/December 2022 is as follows: recognizing the fact there was recently a city council election in Albany and there were multiple candidates, 2 of which were duly elected, the City Council shall appoint the candidate not elected for a contested City Council seat who received the highest number of votes, provided said candidate received at least three-fourths (3/4) of the election threshold for this election in the final round in the ranked choice tabulation to a seat on the City Council for a 2 year term commencing on December 12, 2022 and ending December 2024.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity has no effect on the other provisions or applications of the Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this extent, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable. The City Council declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance irrespective of the invalidity of any portion thereof.

SECTION 5: PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Mayor shall sign and the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same, or the summary thereof, to be published and posted pursuant to the provisions of law and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by a 4/5 vote.
