2022 Pavement Rehabilitation Project – Approval of Contract Change Order (CCO) #1 to Contract No. C22-30 and Approval of a Rainbow Crosswalk at

Solano Avenue and Talbot Avenue

#### **SUMMARY**

The issue before the Council is to approve installation of a rainbow crosswalk at the southern crossing of the Solano Avenue and Talbot Avenue intersection and to approve Contract Change Order (CCO) #1 to Contract No. C22-30 in the amount of \$115,965.60 to add asphalt patch paving repair at various locations around the City and construction of rainbow crosswalks at two locations on Solano Avenue. This change order is within the appropriated budget for the Annual Street Rehabilitation Program (CIP No. 21000) and no budget adjustments are needed at this time.

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

That the Council adopt Resolution No. 2022-128:

- 1. Approving installation of a rainbow crosswalk at the southern crossing of the Solano Avenue and Talbot Avenue intersection, and
- 2. Authorizing the City Manager to execute CCO #1 to Contract No. C22-30 in the amount of \$115,965.60 using funds previously appropriated as part of the City's Annual Street Rehabilitation Program (CIP No. 21000).

#### **BACKGROUND**

The City of Albany currently maintains 30 centerline miles of roads representing over five million square feet of pavement. In November 2020, Council approved the five-year Capital Improvement Plan (Resolution No. 2020-108), and appropriated budget for the first three fiscal years of the plan, including the Annual Street Rehabilitation Program (CIP No. 21000).

On October 17, 2022 the City Council awarded Contract No. C22-30 to Bay Cities Paving and Grading, Inc. to construct the 2022 Pavement Rehabilitation Project (Project) (Resolution No. 2022-105). The Project consists of pavement rehabilitation, asphalt grinding, base repair, and other improvements for curb ramp and storm drains.

#### Rainbow Crosswalks

On September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022, staff presented plans for a rainbow crosswalk at the south crossing of the Solano/Cornell intersection to Transportation Commission and the Commission recommended approval of the rainbow crosswalk to Council with a secondary recommendation to consider adding a second rainbow crosswalk at the Solano/Talbot intersection. On October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022, Staff presented Transportation Commission's recommendations to City Council and Council approved the design of the rainbow crosswalk and the Solano/Cornell location.

On December 1, 2022, staff presented the Solano/Talbot location to the Transportation Commission and the Commission recommended approval of the second rainbow crosswalk to Council.

#### Patch Paving

In Summer 2022, staff assessed the condition of city streets for isolated locations of pavement sag, rutting, cracking, and presence of potholes around the City. Staff evaluated the extent of the damage, determined the quantities needed to complete base repairs and patch pave the damaged locations, then proceeded to solicit bids from roadway contractors as a standalone pavement repair project. Ten contractors were contacted to provide bids to complete the repairs as a standalone project and zero responses were received. Therefore, staff elected to include the patch paving work as part of a larger future pavement rehabilitation project that already included similar pavement repair work.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Staff identified the 2022 Pavement Rehabilitation Project as an appropriate project due to similar scope and coinciding locations of work and requested Bay Cities Paving and Grading provide a cost proposal to add the patch paving project and installation of two rainbow crosswalks.

Bay Cities Paving and Grading provided proposals in the amount of \$111,559.00 for the patch paving and \$4,406.60 for the rainbow crosswalks, for a total proposed cost of \$115,632.60. The proposal increases the existing quantities for base repair and paving at the bid unit price, adds cost of mobilization of additional equipment specific to the patch paving work, adds rainbow colored triple four striping, and associated traffic control costs. Staff reviewed the proposal and found it to be reasonable and consistent with estimated costs. The proposed CCO #1 will revise the contract price from \$1,998,381.00 to \$2,114,346.60.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE**

This project consists of rehabilitation of existing streets and is determined to be categorically exempt under CEQA (California Environmental Quality Act) Guideline Section 15301 Existing Facilities.

#### **SUSTAINABILITY**

The proposed project supports Council's Strategic Plan in the areas of Transportation Safety and Implementation of the city's Active Transportation Plan.

#### **FINANCIAL SUMMARY**

As of November 22, 2022, the City has either spent or encumbered approximately \$8.7 million of the total appropriated program budget for the noted fiscal years. This includes the base Contract No. C22-30 for Bay Cities as noted above.

The proposed change order recommended in this staff report is within the approved budget for the Annual Street Rehabilitation Program (CIP No. 21000) and no new appropriations are recommended at this time.

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL APPROVING INSTALLATION OF A RAINBOW CROSSWALK AT THE SOUTHERN CROSSING OF THE SOLANO AVENUE AND TALBOT AVENUE INTERSECTION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER #1 TO CONTRACT NO. C22-30 WITH BAY CITIES PAVING AND GRADING IN A NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$115,965.60

WHEREAS, the City of Albany maintains 30 miles of public streets and roadways, with an overall pavement condition index (PCI) of 56 as calculated by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC); and

**WHEREAS,** on November 16, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-108 for the FY19/20-23/24 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and appropriated budget for the first three fiscal years of the program; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Street Rehabilitation Program (CIP No. 21000) is included in the CIP, and reflects the City's commitment to ongoing investment into improving and maintaining City street conditions, including the Citywide PCI, on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the award for the 2022 Pavement Rehabilitation Project Contract No. C22-30 to Bay Cities Paving and Grading, Inc. for pavement rehabilitation and other improvements within the City; and

WHEREAS, Staff identified additional isolated locations of pavement patching and repair unsuitable for a large-scale paving project; and

WHEREAS, Staff solicited cost proposals for pavement patching and repair as an individual project from ten contractors and found zero responses within the allotted time; and

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
