**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL TO AMEND
THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 BUDGETED APPROPRIATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2022-23 budget was passed on June 7, 2021; and

WHEREAS, several structural and economic changes have occurred since the budget was adopted; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to amend the budget to reflect those changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby increases the Fiscal Year 2022-23 General Fund appropriations by \$223,100; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council approves a proportional increase in transfers to the General Fund from Special Revenue Funds to cover increases to the Public Works budget not to exceed \$95,100; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council increase appropriations to the Emergency Medical Services Fund by \$50,000 to cover a change in the Ground Emergency Medical Transport program.
