SUBJECT: Amending Ordinance Relating to Student and Student-Affiliated

Appointments to City Advisory Bodies

SUMMARY

This report is provided based on direction from the City Council on March 20, 2023 to establish policy regarding the filling of student and student-affiliated seats on City Advisory Bodies.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

That the Council adopt Ordinance No. 2023-02, amending sections of the Albany Municipal Code related to the Parks, Recreation & Open Space Commission and the Transportation Commission regarding student and student-affiliated appointments, second reading, pass-to-print.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

On January 17, 2023 the Council discussed nominations made by the Board of Education to City Council Advisory Bodies as introduced by Council Member Jordan. The Council established an ad hoc committee comprised of Council Members Hansen-Romero and Jordan to further study the matter and provide recommendations. The <u>ad hoc committee provided a memo to the Council</u> and further discussed the item on February 6, 2023. The Council agreed that the item should be discussed with the Board of Education to solicit feedback regarding potential policy updates.

Vice Mayor Miki attended a Board of Education meeting on March 14, 2023, and <u>provided a memo to the Council</u> as part of the March 20, 2023 meeting of the City Council. During the discussion at the March 20, 2023 meeting, the Council provided direction to draft policy language regarding student and student-affiliated appointments to certain Advisory Bodies to the City Council including the Arts Committee, Climate Action Committee, Parks, Recreation & Open Space Commission, Policing Commission, and the Transportation Commission.

The City Council adopted Resolution No. 2023-21 on April 17, 2023, updated the policy for Arts Committee, Climate Action Committee, Policing Commission, and Racial Inclusivity & Social Equity Commission. At the same meeting, City Council also introduced Ordinance No.

2023-02 and waived first reading of the Ordinance to amend sections of the Albany Municipal Code related to the Parks, Recreation & Open Space Commission and the Transportation Commission regarding student and student-affiliated appointments.

The Ordinance includes the same policy language as the Resolution adopted, generally described as follows:

Each advisory body mentioned above will be comprised of 7 Members, all appointed by the City Council. Appointments shall be in accordance with Section 3.23 of the Albany City Charter, however, the Albany student and student-affiliated seats do not need to be residents of the City, and the term for these seats will be consistent with the 2-year term for all advisory body members.

- One (1) appointment made by each City Council Member,
- One (1) appointment made by the City Council as a whole to be filled by a high school student attending a high school within the City of Albany,
- One (1) appointment made by the City Council as a whole to be filled by either a high school student attending a high school within the City of Albany or an adult affiliated with students at the school level within the City of Albany.

SUSTAINABILITY/SOCIAL EQUITY CONSIDERATION

The updated policy allows for the City Council to appoint a high school level student as well as a community member affiliated with school level students to increase youth representation and engagement within local government. Further, the action to extend this policy to multiple Advisory Bodies to the City Council ensures consistency across the City's advisory bodies to obtain input from youth in a variety of key local government priority areas.

NEXT STEPS

Pending action by the Council, staff will further engage with each of the high schools within the City as well as conduct general outreach to the community regarding the opportunity for applying to serve in a student or student-affiliated seat on City Advisory Bodies. Applications received will be provided to the City Council for consideration. Council as a whole appointments may be proposed by any member of the City Council for confirmation by the Council as a whole as part of a City Council meeting. Staff will work to develop an orientation training for new student/student-affiliated appointees as they are beginning the 2-year term after the regular Advisory Body & Brown Act Training that is conducted every two years which was conducted on March 2, 2023.

	SECTION 1: CHAPTER II OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION

26	There is hereby established within the City a commission to be known as the "Parks Recreation and Open Space Commission of the City". The Parks, Recreation and Open Space

28	a. Five (5) members of such Commission shall be appointed by Councilmembers each Councilmember shall appoint one (1) member to the Commission.

12	SECTION 3: PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be posted at three public places within the City of Albany and shall
13	become effective thirty days after the date of its posting.
