3	A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CALL FOR BIDS FOR THE SAN PABLO AVENUE PEDESTRIAN
4	IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT – PHASE 1 (CIP NO. 24010)

6	WHEREAS, the City of Albany has been conducting public workshops and developing
7	plans for pedestrian safety improvements and enhanced pedestrian facilities along San Pablo
8	Avenue; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, as detailed in the City's current five-year Capital Improvement Plan,
11	adopted in November 2020, the City of Albany has decided to phase San Pablo Avenue
12	Improvements to adapt to budget constraints, with Phase I (CIP No. 24010) consisting of
13	pedestrian safety and accessibility improvements along San Pablo Avenue between Brighton
14	Avenue to Portland Avenue (hereinafter referred to as "Phase I Project"); and
15	
16	WHEREAS, City was awarded \$340,000 in federal funding through Round Two of the
17	One Bay Area Grant Program (OBAG2) for construction of the Phase I Project; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, Grant funding for the federal OBAG2 grant requires compliance with
20	Federal-Aid provisions in the Caltrans Local Assistance Procedures Manual (LAPM); and
21	
22	WHEREAS, City has complied with all the LAPM Federal-Aid provisions for the Phase
23	I Project, including Caltrans approval of plans, specifications, and estimate; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, City has received Federal-Aid authorization to proceed with construction
26	(E-76) in June of 2023; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, The project is Categorically Exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section
20	15301 "Existing Facilities" of the CEOA Guidelines, which exempts the operation, repair,

maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing streets, sidewalks, and pedestrian crossings. As part of the federal-aid requirements, Caltrans has determined that this project is also a Categorical Exclusion under NEPA: 23 CFR 771.117(c): activity (c)(3).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council authorizes the City Manager to approve a Call for Bids for Contract No. C23-08 for the San Pablo Pedestrian Improvements – Phase I, using funds previously appropriated as part of the City's current five-year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP No. 24010).
