ACT is a mobile crisis team operating four days per week, comprised of a Behavioral Health Clinician and Peer Support Specialist. The purpose of ACT is to meet the needs of Albany community members experiencing crises that may require mental health services.

The team responds to mobile crisis calls through 911 and non-emergency calls. Additionally they provide follow-up sessions when needed to support community members.

ACT program services are provided by Bonita House, Inc., a local non-profit 501 (c)(3) which has extensive experience in providing crisis intervention in a wide range of community settings preventing and managing crises.
