

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-76

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING AWARD FOR THE SAN PABLO AVENUE PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT – PHASE 1 (CIP NO. 24010)

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has been conducting public workshops and developing plans for pedestrian safety improvements and enhanced pedestrian facilities along San Pablo Avenue; and

WHEREAS, as detailed in the City's current five-year Capital Improvement Plan, adopted in November 2020, the City of Albany has decided to phase San Pablo Avenue Improvements to adapt to budget constraints, with Phase I (CIP No. 24010) consisting of pedestrian safety and accessibility improvements along San Pablo Avenue between Brighton Avenue to Portland Avenue (hereinafter referred to as "Phase I Project"); and

WHEREAS, City was awarded \$340,000 in federal funding through Round Two of the One Bay Area Grant Program (OBAG2) for construction of the Phase I Project; and

WHEREAS, City has received Federal-Aid Authorization to Proceed with construction (E-76) in June of 2023 and the funding source requires award of project within six months; and

WHEREAS, the project is Categorically Exempt from (California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 "Existing Facilities" of the CEQA Guidelines, which exempts the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing streets, sidewalks, and pedestrian crossings. As part of the federal-aid requirements, Caltrans has determined that this project is also a Categorical Exclusion under NEPA: 23 CFR 771.117(c): activity (c)(3); and

WHEREAS, the project was twice advertised in the local newspaper, posted on the City website and distributed to several Bay Area builders' exchanges, and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2023, the City received and opened nine (9) bids for the above-mentioned project; and

WHEREAS, GradeTech, Inc. was found to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, with a base bid of \$998,721.60 and bid alternate in the amount of \$21,768.90, for a combined contract total of \$1,020,490.50 for the construction of the San Pablo Avenue Pedestrian Improvements – Phase 1; and

WHEREAS, additional construction management and engineering services are necessary to support staff during project advertisement and construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute Contract No. C23-08 with GradeTech, Inc. to construct the San Pablo Avenue Pedestrian Improvements - Phase I in a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,020,490.50; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute Contract Amendment #1 for Contract No. C22-32 with Zoon Engineering, Inc. to provide construction management support for the San Pablo Avenue Pedestrian Improvements - Phase I, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$150,570.20; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute Contract Amendment #2 for Contract No. C21-58 with BKF to provide engineering support services, as needed, in a not-to-exceed amount of \$62,800.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby appropriates \$236,000 from Measure BB Local Streets & Roads (Fund 1201) funds and adjusts the project budget accordingly.
