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WHEREAS, Urban Tilth has provided an updated schedule of tasks and costs for stewardship and restoration services on Albany Hill, Cerrito Creek, and Codornices Creek for an additional one year term, which Staff has deemed to be worthwhile in light of the benefits and opportunities that will accrue to local young adults and the quality of the service delivered to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute Change Order #1 for Contract No. C21-28 with Urban Tilth in the amount of \$106,666.99 for the Albany Creeks & Open Space Maintenance and Restoration Program, using funds from a Wildfire Resilience Grant from the State Coastal Conservancy, funds provided for Codornices Creek maintenance of restoration areas as part of the MOU with the City of Berkeley and UC Berkeley, and funds previously appropriated as part of the Public Works operating budget.
