**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL TO APPROVE  
A TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE FOR THE  
ALBANY MOVE'N'GROOVE EVENT AND WAIVER OF PERMIT FEES**


**WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code Section 21101 requires the City to approve by resolution the temporary closure of any street for celebrations, parades, local special events, and other purposes when the closing is necessary for the safety and protection of persons who are to use that portion of the street during the temporary closure; and

**WHEREAS**, use of the public right-of-way is regulated by Section 14-2 of the Albany Municipal Code. Per the Municipal Code, applications for work or use of the public right of way are processed in the form of an encroachment permit, which is subject to the approval of the Community Development Director; and

**WHEREAS**, Move'n'Groove is a one day 5 K walk/run and music event around the Memorial Park and the Albany High School blocks; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council hereby approves the partial closure of Key Route Boulevard, and closure of Portland Avenue, Thousand Oaks Boulevard, and Carmel Avenue adjacent to Albany High School; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council authorizes staff to issue an encroachment permit for the Albany Move'n'Groove event on April 14, 2024 and waive the permit fees for this event.
