Responses to Questions

- 1) You specify that we are to install, monitor, and operate up to 12 flow meters. We want to make sure whether you want us to include the cost of the meters (and related hardware/software) as an "Other Direct Cost" in our proposal, or will the City purchase the meters and supply them to us?

The City will not supply flow meters.

- 2) Will the City want paper, bound copies of the WMP, or will digital copies suffice? If you do want paper/bound copies, how many would you want?

Proposals may assume two hard bound copies of the final Watershed Management Plan.

- 3) For the pipeline CCTV inspections, do we need (i.e., is it a City requirement) to use prevailing wages for the contractors doing the work.

Subconsultants are expected to be subject to applicable requirements set by the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR).

- 4) We assume the pipeline inspection contractor will do their own traffic control, as needed. Are there any permits that need to be obtained to do the inspections?

Work in the public right-of-way will require an encroachment permit. Applications may be found on the City website. Encroachment permits for City projects will not require an application fee.
