SUBJECT: City Council Ad Hoc Subcommittee to review applications and make

recommendations on appointments to the Housing Advisory

Commission

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

That the Council select two members to form an ad hoc subcommittee to review applications received from members of the community seeking appointment to the newly established Housing Advisory Commission and make a recommendation to the City Council regarding the appointees to the Commission for ratification by the City Council.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

On March 4, 2023, the City Council unanimously adopted <u>Resolution No. 2024-13</u> establishing a Housing Advisory Commission (HAC) to provide a forum to engage with members of the community across a range of perspectives on housing policies and programs and to make recommendations to the City Council regarding implementation of the City's Housing Element. The five member HAC shall be comprised of, at a minimum, one tenant, one affiliate of a local educational institution, and one rental provider that may either be a resident of, or provide rental housing within, the City of Albany.

To further ensure balance of composition and diversity of perspective of the HAC to the extent practicable, Council requested formation of a subcommittee to review all applications received and to make a recommendation to the City Council regarding the appointees to the HAC.

The shared goal for all City services is to provide and advance fair and equitable services to the Albany community, including promoting and furthering equal access to affordable housing opportunities through the City and establishing advisory bodies with a diversity of membership representing a spectrum of perspectives.

The establishment of a subcommittee to review applications and present a recommendation to Council will facilitate the formation of the Housing Advisory Commission, which will make progress towards
