


1 **WHEREAS**, the Transportation Commission has reviewed a staff-level analysis of the
2 year-long pilot project and recommended that Council direct staff to prepare designs to
3 implement the contraflow bicycle lane option while giving serious consideration to
4 maintaining the existing pilot configuration and implementing the two-way through traffic with
5 forced right turns configuration due to the Transportation Commission's uncertainty and out
6 of respect for absent Commissioners; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Caltrans provides planning grants to municipal governments for various
9 types of transportation initiatives. In fiscal year 2024-2025, Caltrans will award approximately
10 \$568 million in grants for local and regional active transportation projects that are consistent
11 with their Active Transportation Program.

13 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council does
14 hereby:
15

- 16 1. Direct staff to prepare designs for a revised layout of Kains and Adams that
17 includes: 1-way motor vehicle traffic, a contraflow bicycle lane, parallel parking,
18 wayfinding signage, additional intersection treatments to facilitate safer crossings
19 at all intersections, and additional measures to address vehicle volumes on the 700
20 and 800 block of Kains and the 900 block of Adams; and
- 21 2. Authorize the City Manager to submit a grant application for the Kains and Adams
22 Bikeway to the California Active Transportation Program and enter into a funding
23 agreement with Caltrans upon award of a grant.
