RESOLUTION NO. 2024-50

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING THE PIERCE-CLEVELAND BIKEWAY CONNECTION PROJECT (CIP NO. 25016), APPROPRIATING MEASURE BB BICYCLE & PEDESTRIAN FUNDS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT THE PROJECT FOR A GRANT, EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION IF AWARDED, AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, in April 2012, the City Council adopted the Albany Active Transportation Plan, which serves as the City’s bicycle master plan and pedestrian master plan; and

WHEREAS, the Active Transportation Plan identified the Pierce Street Path as a priority project; and

WHEREAS, in 2012, the Pierce Street Path Segment I was completed; and

WHEREAS, portions of the southern half of the Pierce Street Path Segment II are either planned for construction by Satellite Affordable Housing Associates or in design under the City’s Cleveland Avenue Paving, Storm Drain, and Bikeway Project; and

WHEREAS, the northern half of the Pierce Street Path Segment II has not yet begun design nor secured necessary design and construction funding; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) provides grants to municipal governments for various types of transportation initiatives for local and regional active transportation projects that are consistent with their Safe Routes to Transit & Bay Trail Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council does hereby authorize establishment of the Pierce-Cleveland Bikeway Connection Project (CIP No. 25016); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council does hereby appropriate \$50,000 from Alameda County Transportation Commission (Alameda CTC) Measure BB Bicycle & Pedestrian Direct Local Distributions funds to the project for conceptual design and preparation of cost estimates for grant application; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council does hereby authorize the City Manager to submit a grant application to the MTC Safe Routes to Transit & Bay Trail Program for the Pierce-Cleveland Bikeway Connection Project, enter into a funding agreement with MTC upon award of grant, and authorize grant funds awarded for expenditure on the project.
