

AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO CONTRACT #C07-13

**AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN
THE CITY OF ALBANY
AND
URS CORPORATION**

**TO PROVIDE FIELD OBSERVATION
AND TESTING SERVICES DURING CONSTRUCTION
FOR NEILSON STORM DRAIN PROJECT**

This AMENDMENT to the AGREEMENT FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES ("AGREEMENT"), is made and entered into this ___ day of _____ 2008 by and among the City of Albany a California charter city ("CITY") and URS Corporation a [California corporation, partnership, LLC or LLP, or individual] ("CONSULTANT").

In consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

SECTION 1. TERM OF AGREEMENT.

Subject to the provisions of SECTION 19 "TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT" of this AGREEMENT, the term of this AGREEMENT shall be for a period of one (1) year from the date of execution of this AGREEMENT, as first shown above. Such term may be reduced or extended upon written agreement of both parties to this AGREEMENT.

SECTION 2. SCOPE OF SERVICES.

CONSULTANT agrees to perform the services set forth in the attached Proposal from URS dated July 8, 2008 for field observation and testing services during construction of the Neilson Storm Drain Project, and made a part of this AGREEMENT.

SECTION 4. COMPENSATION AND METHOD OF PAYMENT.

Subject to any limitations set forth in this AGREEMENT, CITY agrees to pay CONSULTANT the amounts specified in the attached Proposal under "Task Summary" and made a part of this AGREEMENT. The additional compensation, including reimbursement for actual expenses, shall not exceed THIRTY THOUSAND SEVENTY EIGHT dollars (\$30,078), and the total contract amount shall not exceed TWO HUNDRED FOUR THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY FOUR dollars (\$204,374), unless additional compensation is approved in writing by the City Council or City Administrator.
