3	RESOLUTION OF THE ALBNAY CITY COUNCIL INITIATING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CIRCULATION ELEMENT OF THE
4	GENERAL PLAN AND AUTHORIZING AN ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW FOR CONSIDERATION OF THE POSSIBLE CLOSURE OF ALBANY STREETS
5	ADJOINING EL CERRITO PLAZA
6	WHEREAS, residents have cited unacceptable increases in traffic volume, speeds, and
7	truck traffic using residential streets to enter and exit El Cerrito Plaza; and
8	WHEREAS, traffic volume data shows a possible 19 to 20 percent increase in traffic
9	following the renovation of the El Cerrito Plaza; and
11	WHEREAS, on April 22, 2004, the Albany Traffic & Safety Commission heard testimony
12	from Albany residents regarding increased traffic concerns and decreased livability, at which time
13	the Commission voted 4-0 (one absent) that the City Council consider street closure (except to
14	pedestrian, bicycles, and emergency vehicles); and
15	WHEREAS, on December 14, 2004, the Planning & Zoning Commission heard testimony
16	from Albany residents regarding increased traffic concerns and decreased livability, at which time
17 18	the Commission voted 4-0 (one abstention) to consider street closure (except to pedestrian,
19	bicycles, and emergency vehicles).
20	NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE that:
21	1. An Amendment to the Circulation Element of the General Plan be initiated;
22	2. An environmental review of that amendment be prepared to evaluate such closure; and
23	3. The City Council consider the findings and possible action at a public hearing
24	following review and recommendation by the Planning & Zoning Commission.
