A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH KORVE ENGINEERING TO PREPARE ENGINEERING PLANS FOR PHASE I OF THE

WHEREAS, the City of Albany City Council approved Resolution No. 02-52 on July 1, 2002, approving the reconfiguration of Marin Avenue from 4 lanes to 3 travel lanes (2 travel lanes, and 1 middle turning lane), adding bike lanes, and changing the striping and signage to improve vehicular, pedestrian and bicycle safety on Marin, and implement traffic calming

WHEREAS, the City of Albany City Council approved Resolution No. 04-57 on November 15, 2004, certifying the Negative Declaration for the Marin Avenue Reconfiguration

WHEREAS, four responses to the Request for Proposal were received for preparation of

WHEREAS, staff recommends that Korve Engineering be awarded the contract for a not to exceed amount of \$39,000 for preparation of plans, specifications, and estimates; and

WHEREAS, the City received a \$120,000 TFCA grant toward engineering and construction of Phase I of the Marin Avenue Project, which requires a 50% City match of \$120,000 previously authorized from Measure F monies through approval of the Capital

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council authorizes the City Administrator to execute a contract with Korve Engineering for a not to exceed amount of \$39,000 to prepare engineering plans for Phase I, and conduct before and after monitoring for
