4	A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
5	CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO CALL FOR BIDS FOR THE MARIN AVENUE
6	RECONFIGURATION PROJECT

8	WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution #02-52 on July 1, 2002, approving
9	the reconfiguration of Marin Avenue from 4 lanes to 3 lanes (2 travel lanes and 1 middle turning
	lane), adding bike lanes, slurry sealing the roadway, and changing the striping and signage to
10	improve vehicular, pedestrian and bicycle safety on Marin Avenue; and
11	WHEREAS, on February 22, 2005, the City Council awarded a contract to Korve
12	Engineering to prepare engineering plans for the Marin Avenue project, which includes "before
13	and after" monitoring; and
14	WHEREAS, construction of the project is anticipated to begin in July 2005 and be
15	completed prior to the start of the 2005 school year; and
	WHEREAS, engineering cost estimates for construction total \$280,000 based on 35%
16	plans; and
17	WHEREAS, adequate funding exists for construction in that \$120,000 in grant monies
18	has been received through a TFCA grant, \$180,000 has been allocated from Measure F,
19	approximately \$37,000 will be available in Measure B – ACTIA funds, and \$50,000 will be
20	available in July 2005 from Gas Tax monies; and
21	WHEREAS, plans are nearing completion and authorization to Call for Bids at this time
22	will enable the project to remain on schedule.
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby:
24	Authorizes the City Administrator to invite bids for the implementation of the Marin Avenue Reconfiguration project.
