  - Art in the Park Projects- Ocean View, Memorial Park: OV: Adame, the letters were painted gold and the art piece has finally been completed. MP: Wishner, Gina Telcocci presented a new plan for "Long Song", Memorial Park Sculpture. The wear on the burm has presented new issues and Telcocci suggested adding flagstones on the top area (worn out area) of the sculpture, she is planning to present the flagstone samples to the committee in October's meeting. She is hoping that the committee can approve some of the changes so she can begin to plant new burm in October. The committee expressed some concern over the safety and accessibility for all with the new flagstones being considered. Wishner will speak to Barry Whitaker regarding this matter. Gina agreed to bring a sample of the flagstone, sketch of stone path, also considering stones in mortar option.
