STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Adopt Resolution No. 08-72 – A Resolution of the Albany City Council Amending Resolution Numbers 80-50, 87-58, 88-37, 90-122, 92-71, 93-12, 98-9, 02-48 and 04-24 Which Will Continue to Adhere to the Conflict of Interest Code, as Adopted and Incorporated by Reference Pursuant to the Fair Political Practices Commission Standard Conflict of Interest Code.

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to State requirements the City is required annually to review its Conflict of Interest Code and make changes, as necessary.

DISCUSSION

The City has not changed its Code since 2004 and there have been some new positions added and changes made to position titles for example: Added Assistant City Administrator and changed the title for the Human Resources Manager. Therefore, it is recommended that the City Council adopt a new Resolution with the changes incorporated into its Conflict of Interest Code.
