Since 2007 I have been Senior Manager of Utility Partnerships at 3Degrees where I oversee the utility green pricing (renewable energy) efforts of three Bay Area municipal electric utilities. I spent the previous seven years at the non-profit Center for Resource Solutions as managing Green-e, the nation's certification program for renewable energy. I previously worked as Energy Product Manager at Utility.com, an internet-based green power marketer, and was Energy Efficiency Project Coordinator for the City of San Jose. I received MBA and Master of Public Affairs degrees from The University of Texas at Austin, and a BA in History from Macalester College. I installed 1kW of solar PV on the roof of my Albany home.

My objective as a Sustainability Committee member is to help Albany become the most energy-efficiency and renewable energy powered city in the U.S. Like the others in the committee, I have multiple environmental objectives for Albany. Mine include increasing bicycle and pedestrian travel, increasing energy efficiency, and reducing greenhouse gas emissions. My previous positions with the City of San Jose and City of Austin, Texas were in these areas. My "new" job (as of August 2007) is managing renewable energy programs for three (soon four) municipal electric utilities in California -- so that is my strong suit and I am enjoying bringing my professional knowledge of renewable energy such as wind and solar power to the committee.
