b. **1061 Eastshore Highway. Planning Application 07-089. Conditional Use Permit**. Request for approval of a Master Conditional Use Permit for all an existing commercial building with twenty units.

a. 635 San Pablo. Planning Application 07-050. Variance. Design Review. Request for Design Review approval to allow the demolition and reconstruction of the existing Taco Bell Restaurant. The project includes drive-through service, which requires a variance to meet drive-through requirements.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends that the Planning and Zoning Commission discuss the proposed project and provide direction to the applicant on appropriate revisions to the project, such as design and landscaping. If the Commission wishes to approve the proposed project, draft findings and conditions of approval are attached.

**b. 904 Santa Fe. Planning Application 07-087**. **Design Review**. Request for a study session on an application for Design Review of a new mixed-use building, which includes two residential units and one commercial retail space.

Staff recommendation: Receive testimony from the applicant and members of the public. Provide direction to staff on issues of interest during the review process. No action is taken.

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> c. 1157 Brighton Avenue and 420 Cornell Avenue. Planning Application 07-079. Subdivision. Design Review. Request for a study session on an application requesting approval for a subdivision and design review to allow construction of a new two-story, multi-family building.

Staff recommendation: Receive testimony from the applicant and members of the public. Provide direction to staff on issues of interest during the review process. No action is taken.

d. 613 Curtis. Planning Application 07-082. Design Review. Parking Exception.

**Conditional Use Permit**. Request for approval to allow a 514 sq.ft., second-story addition to the rear area of an existing two-story single-family home.

Staff recommendation: Approve.
