19 20	2. Certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested. Simultaneously the same notice may be sent by regular mail. If a notice that is sent by certified mail is returned unsigned, then service shall be deemed effective pursuant to regular mail, provided the notice that was sent by regular mail is not returned.		
21 22	3. of the posted not	Posting the notice conspicuously on or in front of the property. The formice shall be approved by the City Administrator.	
23	B. Service by certified or regular mail in the manner described above shall be effective on the date of mailing.

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3	Proof of service of notice may be made by the certificate of any officer or employee of this City or by affidavit of any person over the age of eighteen years. The proof of service shall show that service was done in conformity with this Code or other provisions of law applicable to		
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5	the subject matter concerned.		
6	2-35.3 Constructive Notice of Recorded Documents		
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8	the Municipal Code or applicable state codes, recordation shall provide constructive notice		
9	information contained in the recorded documents.		
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11	Section 2: Publication		
12	This ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of		
13	Albany, which said newspaper is designated for that purpose, or it shall be posted in three		
14	locations.		
	Section 3: Severability		
15	If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason		
16	held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the

18	fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clause or phrases be declared invalid.
