- Pool operations – revenue generation: Peggy McQuaid, Andy Lincoff, Charlie Blanchard. Action items: read “Albany High School Pool Financial Analysis” by Sports Management Group (make photocopies – Charlie)
- Funding: all. Action items: obtain information on federal stimulus funds (Nick); possibility of local GHG offsets (David)
