

Benicia Camel Barn and Old State Capitol



Join us for a 2-hour docent-led tour of the Camel Barn. The Museum has more than 8,000 artifacts and 4,500 photographs of which a small number are on display. After lunch at Venticello's, you will have a first hand look at the Old State Capitol. Benicia was the site of California's third seat of government and served as the state capitol for thirteen months during 1853 and 1854. The original building has been restored with reconstructed period furnishings and exhibits. The interior includes a board-for-board reconstruction of the building's original floor with ponderosa pine. It is now a State Historical park. To wrap up the trip you will have some time on your own to visit some of the small boutiques and shops on First Street.
