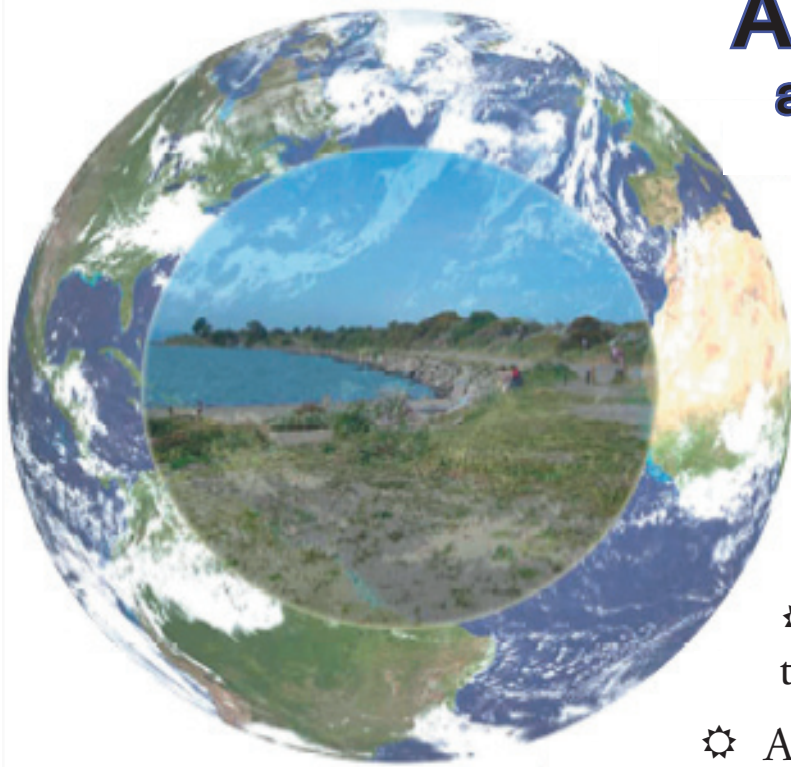


Albany Earth Day Celebration and Clean-up
