**SOCIAL & ECONOMIC JUSTICE COMMISSION (SEJC) RECOMMENDATION**

Establish local economic indicators and consider several items for addressing local concerns. Commission Member Judy Kerr will present a written document to City Council that includes discussion and recommendations on understanding and addressing the impacts of the economy on the residents of Albany.

**BACKGROUND**

In January 2009, the City Council referred the subject of the economy and its impacts on the community to the Social & Economic Justice Commission for its review and recommendations.

The Social & Economic Justice Commission has been discussing this issue since February 2009. The Commission recognized that the issue is quite broad and would need parameters to be defined so that relevant data could be gathered. The Commission has suggested some economic indicators and other information to consider, and has made a couple of specific recommendations.
