| 15 | Section 1: Section 10-4.2, entitled Animals At-Large is hereby enacted and shall read as follows: |
| 16 17 18 | a. Except as otherwise provided, no domestic animal, except cats, shall be permitted to be on public property or the private property of anyone other than the guardian/owner unless under proper control and supervision by a capable person. Any domestic animal found at-large within City limits shall be impounded. |
| 19 | b. It shall be unlawful for dogs to be in designated areas during designated times and days in Albany's parks as set forth by the Albany City Council. The specific days, areas, and hours shall |
| 20 | be adopted by resolution after considering recommendations from the Parks and Recreation Commission. At no time shall dogs be permitted inside the play structure areas of any of |
| 21 | Albany's parks. |
| 22 | Section 2: Publication |
| | This ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of |
| 23 | Albany, which said newspaper is designated for that purpose, or it shall be posted in three |
| 24 | locations. |
| 25 | Section 3: Severability |
| 26 | If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason |
