11	Section 1: Section 1-12, entitled Recovery of Attorney's Fees is hereby enacted and shall read as follows:

13	a. In any action, administrative proceeding, or special proceeding to abate a nuisance, the prevailing party may recover its reasonable Attorney's fees pursuant to Government Code §								
14	38773.5. Recovery of Attorney's fees shall be limited to those individual actions or proceedings in which the City elects, at the initiation of that individual action or proceeding, to seek recovery of its own Attorney's fees. An award of Attorney's fees to a prevailing party shall not exceed the amount of reasonable Attorney's fees incurred by the City in any legal action, administrative

16	proceeding or special proceeding.								
17	b. If any person causes, suffers, maintains or permits a public nuisance to continue after written notice is given to such person by the City, directing such person to abate the nuisance,								
18	and such continuation goes beyond the time set for such abatement in the written notice, the such person shall be liable to the City for the expenses incurred in detecting, investigating and								
19 20	abating the violation, including Attorney's fees and the costs of monitoring compliance. The City may recover such costs by civil action or by billing said person. The City may also recover such costs by special assessment lien if the violation relates to real property.								
21	Section 2: Publication								
	This ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of								
22	Albany, which said newspaper is designated for that purpose, or it shall be posted in three								
23	locations.								
24	Section 3: Severability								
25	If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason								
26	held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the								
27	ordinance, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the								
28	fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clause or phrases be declared invalid.
